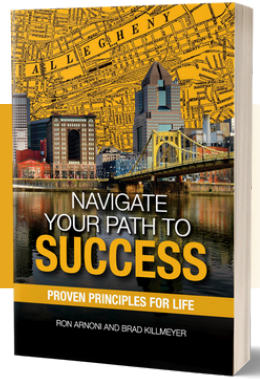


The Ron Arnoni
